## Reading Specialist

CESA #4 offers reading specialist #317 services for districts interested in improving their PK-12 literacy programs and student achievement. **The State of Wisconsin requires each district to employ a DPI-certified reading specialist to develop and coordinate a comprehensive reading curriculum in grades K-12.** A reading specialist may:

- Develop and implement a literacy curriculum in grades K-12
- Act as a resource person to classroom teachers to implement the literacy curriculum
- Work with administrators to support and to implement the literacy curriculum
- Conduct an annual evaluation of the literacy curriculum
- Coordinate the literacy curriculum with other literacy programs and other support services within the school district

Review of remedial literacy support, intervention, and enrichment programming coordination to insure compliance with State Education Standard C and to assist with implementation of Response to Intervention initiatives may be included.

**Service expectations, mutually determined by the district and CESA #4, are based on local identified needs.**
