Safe and Healthy Schools Prevention Services

The purpose of Safe and Healthy Schools Prevention Services is to lead, support, and educate schools to graduate safe and healthy youth. We will offer approximately five to ten workshops to assist districts in responding to needs identified through local district needs assessment and school/community requests. Schools will receive support administering the Youth Risk Behavior Survey and/or technical assistance writing grants that promote safe and healthy schools. Schools participating in Level 1 Basic Service will pay no fee to attend Safe & Healthy Schools events held at CESA #4.

Level 1—Basic Service

Examples of scheduled workshops may include, but are not limited to, the following:

Adult Trainings:

- School Safety Planning and Emergency Preparedness
- Trauma Sensitive School Practices
- Mental Health Issues (Suicide, Depression, Anxiety, Substance Use, and Interventions)
- Bullying Prevention
- Emerging Drug Trends

Level 2—Customized Prevention Service by Design

This service offers your district the opportunity to build a customized, on-site professional development plan. Services can be offered through early release days, late start times, professional development days, or through grade level and collaboration meetings based on your schools' schedules. For each day you purchase you will receive follow-up consultation, implementation assistance, evaluation, or coaching assistance (maximum of half day). Many of the topics align with PBIS universal and selected level implementation.

Some of the topics available: alcohol and other drugs, bullying prevention, grant writing, data collection, suicide prevention, social and emotional skill development, youth leadership, Youth Risk Behavior Survey reporting, and other related topics.
