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## Transition Improvement Grant

The Transition Improvement Grant (TIG) is intended to provide effective, targeted, and low cost professional development to Wisconsin youth, parents, educators and stakeholders in the area of postsecondary transition for students with disabilities. The Transition Improvement Grant will encourage effective practice Postsecondary Transition Plan (PTP) development, with a goal of improving post high school outcomes. This Grant will also focus on providing technical assistance to schools and LEA's on data collection and reporting requirements of state performance plan (SPP) Indicators 13 and 14. The grant will utilize data collected to identify the local needs of school districts, communities and/or counties to provide improvement strategies that will positively affect the post school outcomes of students with disabilities. Information and training on the new Workforce Innovation Opportunity Act (WIOA) is also offered to districts at no cost.
