The Student Services Support and Development program provides professional development, networking, and assistance to school counselors, school social workers and other pupil services personnel who support student development. This service will assist in connecting pupil service staff within the CESA #4 region to support student success and best practices, as well as address barriers to learning. In addition, professional development will focus on comprehensive services that are culturally responsive and support all students' development within the academic, career, and personal/social domains.

Level 1 - Basic Service

- Three School Counselor/Social Worker Network Meetings at CESA #4 (Fall, Winter, Spring). Topics to be covered include, but are not limited to:

 - Counseling practices
 - Mental health topics
 - Trauma Informed Care school development
 - Counseling trends and updates

 - Student homelessness, unaccompanied youth, foster care and educational stability
 - Student records and confidentiality
 - Culturally responsive practices
 - Student Services mentorship for first year school counselors

Level 2 - On-site training of American School Counselor Association (ASCA) Model Mindsets and Behaviors curriculum development with school counselors

Districts may purchase days and the following publications: "ASCA National Model: A Framework for School Counseling Programs (third edition)," "ASCA National Model Implementation Guide: Foundation, Management and Accountability" and "Making DATA Work, an ASCA National Model Publication." The cost of publications is not included in the day rate.

2A. Districts purchasing Level 2 in addition to Level 1 receive a discounted rate of \$600 per day.

2B. Districts purchasing only Level 2 will pay the standard daily rate of:

1 – 10 days @ \$750 per day

11 – 25 days @ \$700 per day

Over 26 days @ \$650 per day

Level 3 - On-site Student Service Support and Development

Examples of customized on-site support:

- One day, on-site Youth Mental Health First Aid for 30 staff members (additional fee of \$25/staff workbook)
- Customized professional development:
 - Mental Health framework
 - Trauma Informed Care/Adverse Childhood Experiences
 - Compassion Resilience for staff
 - Social Emotional Learning competencies
 - ASCA Model training (for districts that do not purchase Level 1 or Level 2)
